Lingua e civiltà Inglese

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Revision: uso presente semplice (frasi); can/can't; have/have got/ singular and plural nouns.

Unit 7

Functions:

talking about food, drink and diet; Planning a meal, e.g. a picnic; ordering food in a caffè/restaurant; practise saying prices in pound sterling; requesting asking and offering in a caffè/restaurant.

Vocabulary:

food and drink; quantities and containers.

Grammar:

countable and uncountable nouns; quantifiers; Whose...? and possessive pronouns.

Unit 8

Functions:

talking about films and tv programmes; giving opinions; talking about the past, using the past simple of *be* and *be born*.

Vocabulary:

film and TV; adjectives of opinion;

Grammar:

so, such; adjectives ending in *-ing* and *-ed*; past simple (*be, be born*); past time expressions.

Unit 9

Functions:

describing events in the past; showing interest; talking about a party you went to.

Vocabulary:

parties and festivals.

Grammar:

past simple: affirmative, negative, interrogative and short answers, (regular and irregular verbs); verbs and prepositions in questions.

Unit 10

Functions:

talking about school life and school subjects; talking about ability in school subjects using *be good at*, etc.; talking about actions in progress in the past; describing clothes and talking about what someone was wearing.

Vocabulary:

education: school; school subjects; clothes.

Grammar:

present tenses and past simple; expressions to describe ability, e.g. *be good at*; past continuous vs past simple; subject and object questions; when, while, as.

Unit 11

Functions:

making comparisons; talking about the weather; talking about a scary incident.

Vocabulary:

animals; weather.

Grammar:

comparative adjectives; negative comparisons; superlative adjectives.

Unit 12

Functions:

talking about future intentions using *be going to*; talking about predictions and intentions in the past using *was/were going to* and *about to*.

Vocabulary:

life events; intentions and ambitions; illnesses, injuries and accidents.

Grammar:

after; before; when; while; as soon as; *be going to*; *was/were going to*; *be about to*.

Unit 13

Functions:

talking about future arrangements, intentions and events with a timetable; making decisions, offers, requests and promises.

Vocabulary:

vehicles and transport; holidays.

Grammar:

future forms: present continuous; present simple; *be going to*; modal verbs: will and shall.

Unit 14

Functions:

apologising and responding; talking about obligation; talking about rules and laws.

Grammar:

have to; (don't) have to; past simple: (don't) have to; must/mustn't.

Unit 15

Functions:

talking about life experiences; talking about how things happens using adverbs.

Vocabulary:

Life experiences; adverbs of manner.

Grammar:

present perfect with ever and never; irregular past participles; been vs gone; present perfect vs past simple; adverbs of manner and comparative adverbs.
